SIGNAGE UPDATE

To share with everyone and solicit some input, here are three options for neighborhood signage. Please direct discussion of these ideas to the dialogue group at dialogue-group@googlegroups.com



Option 1: Recreate the now broken, original sign with more durable materials in the original location and make a smaller version for the corner of the park.



Option 2: A similar sign in the same place, but a simpler design - also with more durable materials and with a smaller version by the park. This would be about the same cost as Option 1.



Option 3: Raise additional funds and erect a brick and concrete sign with lettering. This would require a significant investment and/or donations from neighbors, but would have much more presence and higher vandal and weather resistance.
