Cute but hungry!

The long winter a has created a tremendous increase in deer activity and plant browsing, largely due to the snow that has been covering the ground for so long. The best defense in this case is a good offense. The use of deer repellants early will train the animals to not forage your sprouting bulbs or other emerging plantings. They are creatures of habit and "training" them to avoid your plants will keep you green and happy all summer.

Leaf and brush pick-up.

Leaf picked up is only scheduled November 7 to December 5, so in the spring, bag them for trash. For grass clippings the City follows a policy of Clip and Leave, which means when you cut your grass, you leave it to be absorbed back into the soil. Branch cuttings will be taken if put out with your non-recycling garbage in a waste container. Please do not pile leaves on the curbside as they will not be collected.
