*****Important information about the disposal of yard waste.*****

City of Trenton
Article 1: Garbage collection—Preparation for collection.

H. **Shrubs, clippings, raking.** Branches, clippings, shrubs and raking in excess of 24 inches but not greater than 4 feet in length, and not in excess of 50 pounds in weight, may be placed at the curb for pickup if securely tied in bundles so as to prevent their being scattered, carried or deposited by the elements upon any street, sidewalk or other public or private place or premises.

I. **Trees, stumps, commercial rubbish and construction waste.** Arrangements for disposal of trees, tree stumps or commercial rubbish and construction waste shall be made by the owner, occupant or person in control of the premises affected, either personally or by agreement with a landscape contractor or other worker engaged in work resulting in such accumulation.

J. **Leaves.** For the period between September 1 and December 31 each year, leaves shall not be combined with residential or commercial waste which is to be collected by the City collection system. During this period, leaves may be disposed of in one of two methods: (1) Leaves may be placed loose at the curbline in front of a property owner's own property; or (2) Leaves may be bagged and placed at the curb only on those days so designated in each neighborhood by the Director of Public Works.

The condensed version:

- Anything in excess of 24" but less than 48" in length must be securely bundled and tied before it is placed at the curb for pickup. If it is not bundled it will not be picked up.
- You may not place branches into your regular garbage containers for pickup on garbage days.
- Trees, stumps, commercial rubbish and waste will not be picked up. You must make arrangements to dispose of this with your contractor.
- Leaves are seasonal so be sure to follow the date range outlined above for disposal.
