Minutes from May 27, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 8:45 at Christina Seix Academy on May 27, 2015 with 20+ members in attendance.

The Association invited the Trenton Property Tax Revaluation team and CEO Ernie DelGuercio, of Appraisal Systems, Inc. to give a brief presentation of what to expect during the revaluation process this year. Over 100 (est) residents from the West Trenton area were in attendance. The CEO assured us that the process will be fair and transparent. After the presentation, the forum was open for public commentary and proceeded with a question and answer session. Residents will be informed on the property tax valuation process in person by an inspector, or if you are not home at the time of inspection, they will leave a note asking you to contact them. All property tax valuation results will be posted to the Appraisal System Inc., website.

The Treasurer reported the Certificate of Deposit rolled over April 27th, 2015 and will stay there until the next roll-over date. A motion was made by Bill Mertz to approve May's Treasurer Report, which was also unanimously approved.
