- 6) **New Business:**
 - a. Maureen Lebel is now a board member of the Trenton Psychiatric Hospital. Meetings are once a month and Maureen encouraged anyone with questions or concerns regarding the Psych Hospital to contact her.
 - b. Mayor Redd Gusciora discussed a variety of Trenton issues:
 1. The city is aware of the ongoing issue of ATV activity. There is still a no pursuit order. Discussion of possible drone use in the future.
 2. The paving project on Stuyvesant Avenue will begin in early May. Note that state funds are being used for this project.
 3. The city now has a homebound program for coronavirus vaccinations. Check the city webpage for more information.
 4. The city is adding tree lighting and street dining over the summer months.
 5. The city will be implementing a new Data Sharing Law Enforcement Program in conjunction with Ewing and Lawrence townships. It will be a Real Time Crime Center.

6. The pavilion in Cadwalader Park now has electricity with lighting to come.
7. The city is investigating the reports regarding cars parked illegally in the neighborhood.
8. 15 new police officers have been added to the force and the murder rate has gone down.
9. The city has purchased pot hole repair equipment.
10. There was general discussion regarding the \$73 million American Recovery Plan. There are plans for a possible advisory group. Some ideas for spending include: covid related expenses, infrastructure improvements, broadband, water improvement.
