

Trenton Neighborhoods



Bordered by Cadwalader Park, Hilvista Boulevard, Cornwall Avenue and Stuyvesant Avenue, Hiltonia is Trenton's prestige neighborhood. Within the bounds of Hiltonia are some of the finest single-family homes in Mercer County.

The neighborhood itself was designed by Frederick Law Olmstead, the designer of adjacent Cadwalader Park and Central Park in New York City.

Hiltonia, located in the extreme end of the City's West Ward, is graced by wide, tree-lined streets and well-landscaped lawns. Residents also enjoy easy access to neighboring Cadwalader Park, which offers recreation and open space amenities.

Hiltonia is the home of many professional couples who have discovered a friendly attractive neighborhood with large, quality residences. Convenient to downtown offices, near both public and private schools, homes in this area offer significant value in comparison to suburban homes. An active civic association enhances neiabborhood spirit.

Homes in Hiltonia range in architectural style from contemporary to large stone classic Tudors. Real estate prices range from \$40,000 to \$140,000.
